The Cleveland Chamber Symphony (CCS) is dedicated to the performance, recording and commissioning of the music of our time. CCS is a self-governed organization and a member of the American Federation of Musicians. Concertmaster pay rate is \$66.30 per rehearsal hour; \$226.44 per performance; and \$106.00 per recording hour. Other core section members receive \$33.15 per rehearsal hour; \$119.34 per performance; and \$53.00 per recording hour. Pension contributions are made at a rate of 8% for rehearsals and performances and 10% for recording services.

Auditioning musicians should prepare two contrasting pieces of their own choice. One of the selections should have been composed after 1950. The auditions will occur on Saturday, March 17, 2007.
